- A period of on-the-job training and employment with a local employer.

How Do I Qualify?

- Be a Parent or Guardian of a Minor Child
- Be a Uinta Country School
 District #I Resident
- Provide proof that You are Legally able to work in the United States
- Meet income requirements
- Be ready to start working once program is completed
- Meet employer physical requirements
