What is Ready To Work?

Ready To Work is a 3-part program designed to help Evanston families become independent through;

- ◆ A period of Life Skills and Job Skills Training followed by
- ◆ A period of Employment Training, (C.N.A., Microsoft Office, Substitute Teacher Training, or Welding) and
- ◆ A period of on-the-job training and employment with a local employer.

How Do I Qualify?

- ◆ Be a Parent or Guardian of a Minor Child
- ◆ Be a Uinta Country School District #1 Resident
- ◆ Provide proof that You are Legally able to work in the United States
- ◆ Meet income requirements
- ◆ Be ready to start working once program is completed
- ◆ Meet employer physical requirements
